
The Sticky Steve Exhibit, 2020

A few more things: Artwork do no later than March 15th, 2020.

You may be one of the artists I've invited who doesn't typically do "portraits". I hope you'll still agree to be a part of this because I think your interpretation will make the project all the more interesting.

You retain all rights to your work. If you want, you can make your work available for purchase out of the gallery, or you can make it not for sale.

I realize I'm not giving any information on why I chose Steve as the centerpiece of this. If you want to know before you start, please email me and I'll get right back to you. Or you may wish to create your portrait without knowing. Also feel free to email me with any other questions or comments you might have. I hope you'll say yes, and thanks for taking the time to consider this.
